

Keig Old Churchyard


This old churchyard is situated within the private policies of Castle Forbes. Access is quite difficult. The best approach is from the B992 from Whitehouse. After crossing the River Don at the Bridge of Keig, enter the castle policies through the gate and bear right across the field, past a small clump of trees. Cross the small burn and proceed up the field following the line of the trees.

The churchyard can be very overgrown at certain times of the year and many of the gravestones are buried below the surface.
