

## PART II.

### CADET BRANCHES.

IN this, the second part of *The House of Forbes*, all the cadet houses are treated ; firstly, those that descend from younger sons of the various Lords Forbes, then those descending from the younger brothers of the 1st Lord, with a chapter on Continental Forbeses and some few notes on distinguished men of the name, whose connection with Aberdeenshire is not known.

From Duncan, second son of James, 2nd Lord Forbes, descend the houses of Corsindae, Balfluig, Monymusk, Leslie, etc. From the third son, Patrick, come those of Corse, Craigievar, Granard, etc.

From a younger son of the 6th Lord, the family of Forbes of Blackton. The younger sons of the Lords of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, who were numerous, mostly died in the foreign wars and left no descendants.

The younger sons and daughters of the 18th Lord have left many descendants who can be found in the peerage, a concise tree only being given of them, facing page 342.

From Sir William Forbes of Pitsligo, besides the family of that name, descend the families of Boyndlie, Newe, Culquhonny, Callendar, Castleton and Rothiemay, and the now extinct families of Sunhoney, Pitallachie, Invernochty, Easter Migvie, Bellabeg, Deskrie, etc., these are in order as they came off from the parent tree.

From Sir John Forbes of Tolquhon, the families of Culloden, Waterton, Thainston, Pitnacalder, Foveran, etc.

From Alistair Cam Forbes of Brux, the famous family of Skellater and those of Ledmacoy, Belnabodach, Kildrummy, Towie, Inverernan, Echt, etc.

Colonel Allardyce had compiled an alphabeted list of places inhabited by Forbes. This has now been divided into four sections as being thus more interesting, and is here given.

Many of the places mentioned will be found on the special map on page xvi.

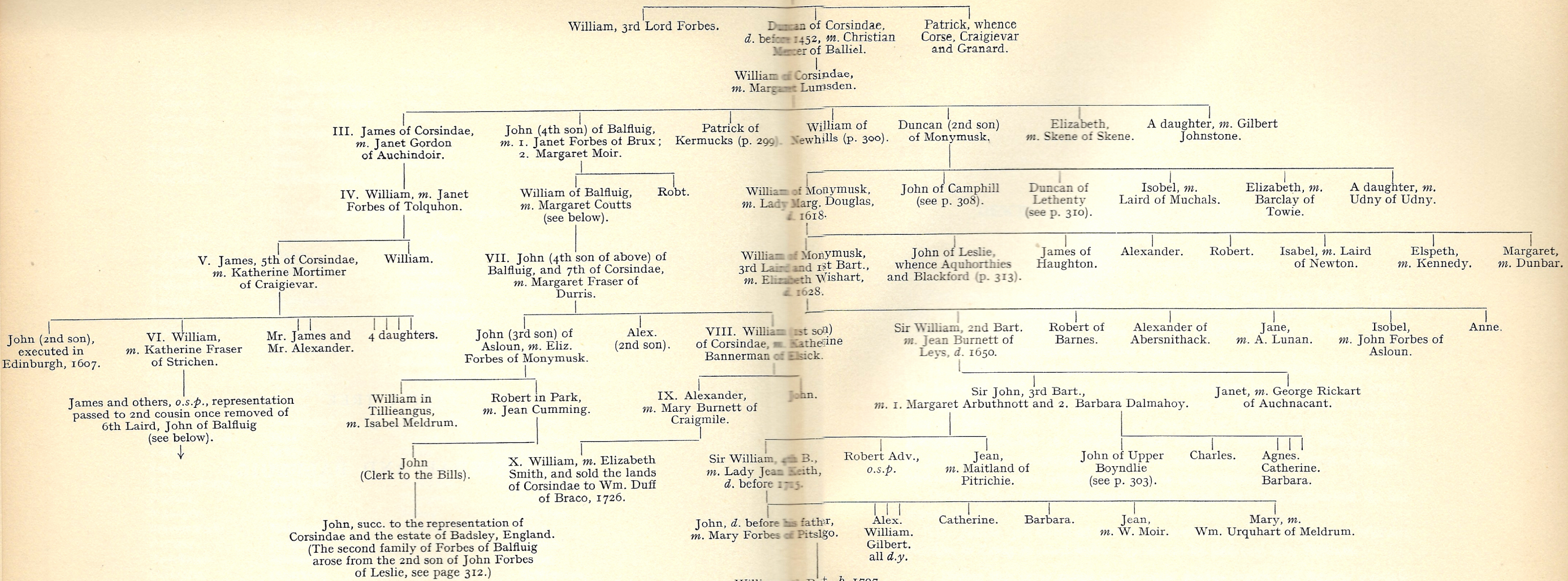
